

Temporary Boating Restriction Issued for Ruth Lake



A temporary boating restriction has been issued at Ruth Lake in an attempt to protect Humboldt County's water supply from invasive species infestation. Only boats registered in and originating from Humboldt and Trinity Counties will be allowed to launch at Ruth Lake. Boats registered locally, but recently in infested waters in southern California or the Colorado river system, are also prohibited.

This restriction is now in place and includes Labor Day weekend. This is a temporary restriction, and should end once boating registration and inspection programs have been put in place. It is anticipated that the programs will be up and running by the end of this year or the beginning of 2009.
