

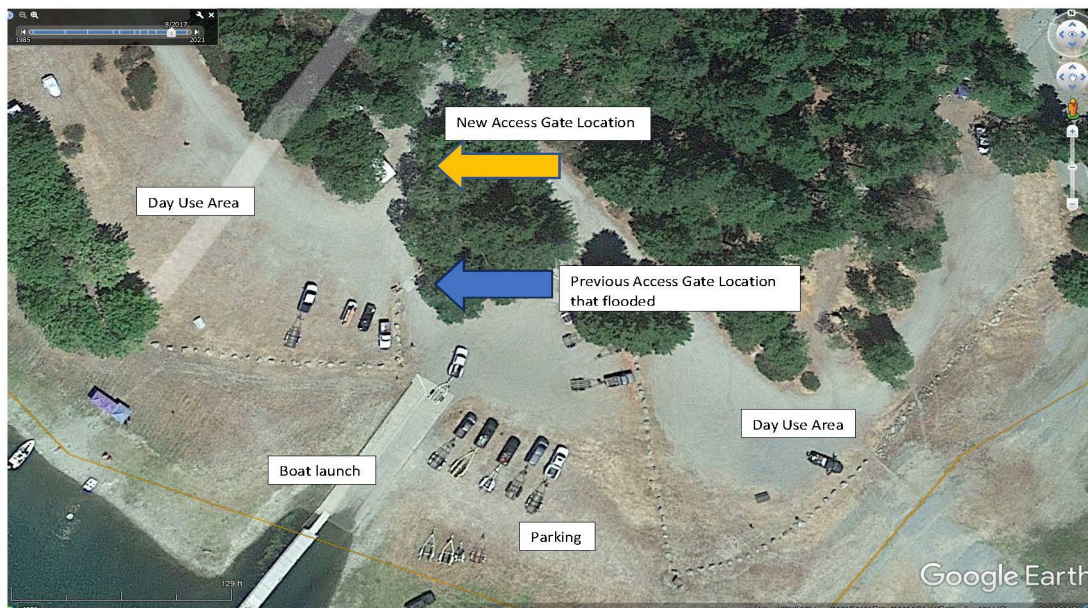
Project Summary for C22Q0803 DBW Quagga and Zebra Mussel Infestation Prevention Grant Program

HBMWD received grant funding for Grant Cycle 2022 in the amount of \$65,306.61 from the Department of Boating and Waterways for Quagga and Zebra Mussel Infestation Prevention.

We were able to utilize all of the grant funding. Funding was used to relocate the electronic gate arm at Ruth Recreation to an area that does not flood. Previously, the gate arm electronics would be underwater during the rainy winter months and the gate arm was not operable as intended. Additional funding was used to install boulders and bollards to redirect users to the new gate arm area and prevent unauthorized access to the lake at the Ruth Recreation site.

The project was successful and the new gate arm is working well and is no longer in the inundation area. This will not only save time and money and going forward, but also provides a more effective process for authorized watercraft users to access the lake. The new access route is clearly delineated with bollards and boulders as well.
